**Scott Memorial Hospital's** mission is Making Communities Healthier®. Here are just a few ways we made Scott County and the surrounding areas healthier in 2017.

**Delivering high quality patient care and supporting our physicians**

The most important contribution we make to our community is providing high quality care close to home. Quality and service are at the center of how we care for our patients, and we continually invest in our facility to ensure we can meet the healthcare needs of our community. In 2017, we made **\$1,141,771 in capital improvements**, including a hospital-wide IV pumps replacement and new sleep study and cardiac rehab equipment.

Inviting the best physicians into our community and supporting them also is a key driver of our efforts to ensure access to high quality care and service. During the past year, Scott Memorial added **28 new providers** in adult and pediatric cardiology, urology, radiology, teleradiology, nephrology, emergency medicine, endocrinology, general surgery and infectious disease.

**Creating excellent workplaces for our employees**

We strive to create an environment where talent is recognized, job satisfaction is valued and our **232 employees** can effectively use their skills in providing high quality care and service; and we managed and distributed an **annual payroll of \$11,889,752**.

Supporting local organizations and delivering healthcare to all of our neighbors, regardless of their ability to pay, are foundational to our commitment to the overall well-being of our community.
